



# 2024 Ice Show: A Toy Story

## LTS Registration

The IceWorks Skating Club's annual ice show is the largest club-sponsored and run event. It serves as the club's sole and most significant fundraiser every year, but most importantly, it provides skaters of every level a special opportunity to showcase their skills and talents for friends, family, and the local community. Our skaters work very hard all year long and this is their chance to celebrate that dedication and commitment.

The theme of the 2024 Annual Ice Show is **A Toy Story**. Show dates are:

**Friday May 10<sup>th</sup>**  
**7:00pm**

**Saturday May 11<sup>th</sup>**  
**7:00pm**

**Sunday May 12<sup>th</sup>**  
**4:00pm**

### Eligibility:

- There are two LTS numbers in the show:
  - **Option 1 rehearses on Wednesdays at 7:00pm-7:30pm.**
  - **Option 2 rehearses on Sundays at 12:30pm-1:00pm.**
- LTS skaters are eligible to skate in either one or both of these numbers.
- Select the number(s) your skater wants to participate in based on when your skater can rehearse. Songs are assigned by the Directors after registration is complete.

### Rehearsals:

- Rehearsals are held at the above times on Sunday afternoons or Wednesday evenings for approximately 7 weeks, beginning the week of Wednesday March 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Each rehearsal is 30 minutes. Skaters are expected to attend all rehearsals and to be prompt.

- **Skaters are also required to attend the following dress rehearsals the week before the show:**

Full Dress Rehearsal	Sunday May 5 <sup>th</sup> 4:00 pm	Everyone MUST ATTEND
Act 1 Full Dress	Tuesday May 7 <sup>th</sup> 5:15 pm	Only skaters in Act 1 numbers must attend
Act 2 Full Dress	Wednesday May 8 <sup>th</sup> 5:00pm	Only skaters in Act 2 number must attend

### Registration & Cost:

- Registration fee is due at the time of registration:
  - \$90 for one number
  - \$165 for two numbers
- This covers the cost of the ice time, coaching and lesson fees, choreography, and costumes.

### Costumes:

- Costumes are selected and purchased by the Directors. **They are yours to keep after the show.**
- As soon as costumes are available, you will be notified via e-mail about fitting times and pick-up.

### Ticket Requirements:

- **Every LTS skater is required to sell a minimum of 6 tickets, prior to the first dress rehearsal.**

### T-Shirts, Cast Posters, Printed Good Luck Wishes, & Program Ads:

- The following items are also available for purchase at the time of registration:
  - Show T-Shirts – souvenir t-shirts with the show logo (\$25 per shirt)
  - Personalized Cast Poster – displayed in the rink during the entire show weekend, for fans to write messages/well wishes (\$5 per poster)
  - Good Luck Wishes – personal messages to skaters are printed in the show program (\$7 per message)
- Program advertising is also available in 3 sizes: business card (\$25), half page (\$50), full page (\$100). Skaters who sell \$100s worth of program ads earn a free show t-shirt.

### Rules/Expectations:

- Skaters are strongly encouraged to miss no more than one rehearsal. Our show is put together in a very short period and we need all skaters' undivided attention and full commitment to ensure they are comfortable and prepared for opening night.
- All absences must be communicated to the coach and Directors prior to any missed rehearsals.
- Poor behavior cannot be tolerated. If behavior is disruptive, skaters may be asked by the coach or Directors to sit out during rehearsal and/or may be removed from the number.
- In the event that a skater is removed or drops from a number, no refund will be granted.
